

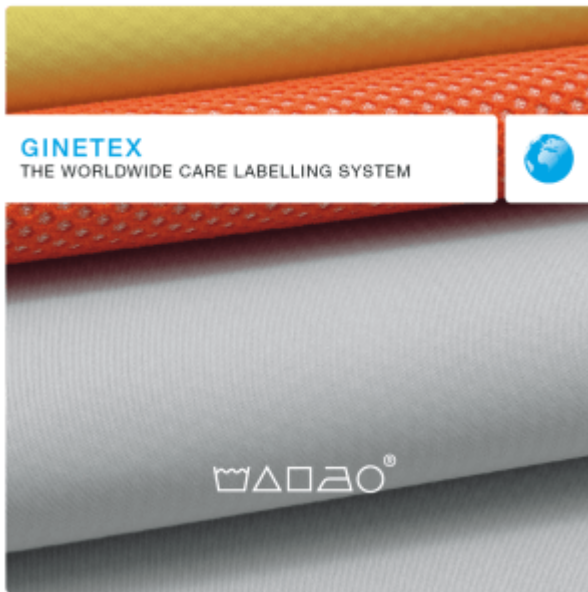

HOW TO JOIN GINETEX AS OBSERVER MEMBER

- be a Standardisation Body or
- be a Private Organisation with a special interest in care labelling or
- be a Governmental Organisation
- pay an annual fee
- have a period of three years before taking advantage of a full GINETEX membership
