

MEMBERSHIP RULES

NATIONAL MEMBERS REPRESENT GINETEX IN THEIR HOME COUNTRIES



In order to become a **National Member** of GINETEX, national committees must comply with the following conditions:

- > have a legal structure conforming to the laws of the relevant country

- > be independent, i.e. autonomous (not to undergo any commercial influence among others), to engage in the protection as trademarks
- > be representative of the textile, garment and care chain (i.e. composed of members from the textile industry,
- > have authority i.e. capacity to enforce its decisions

To become a National Member of GINETEX, national committees must pay an annual fee.
